Se puso menos irritable y aumentó peso; el sarpullido desapareció, pero la fotofobia persistió a un grado menor por un mes después del tratamiento.

Muchas de las señas observadas en el paciente sugieren acrodinia. No había, sin embargo, rojura en las manos y pies, ni excesivo sudor ni lesiones orales.
