

symptoms or psychiatric disease, our short-term follow-up indicates that this has not so far occurred other than in our illustrative case 3 of a patient who dropped out of follow-up psychotherapy. We hope that by teaching the patient and family the cause of the symptom and alternative approaches to stress we will have altered the personality formation and thereby prevented future problems.
