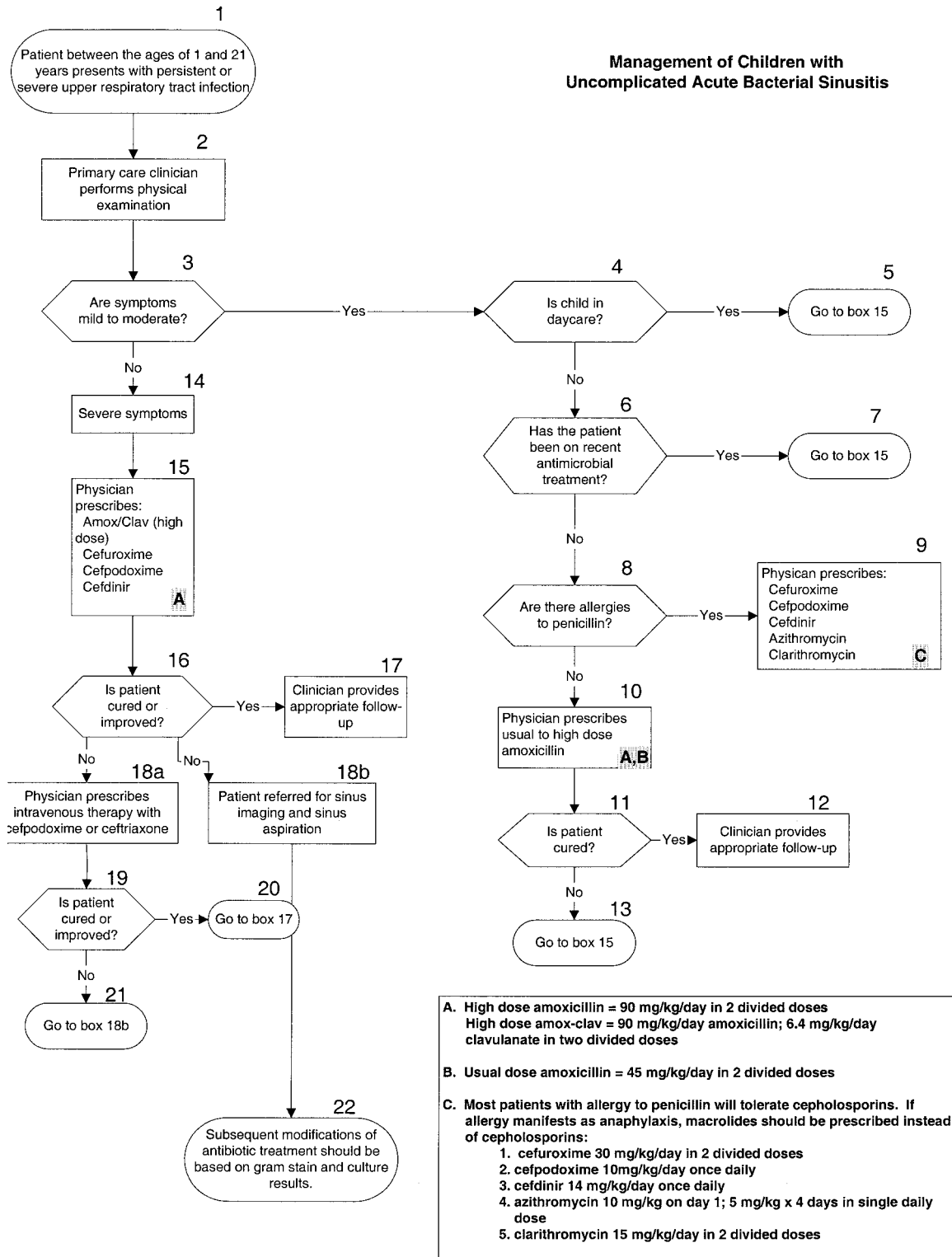


# ERRATUM
