An error occurred in the article by Mazor et al titled "Interpretation of Traumatic Lumbar Punctures: Who Can Go Home?" that appeared in the March 2003 issue of *Pediatrics* (pages 525–528). On page 525, in the right column of the "Conclusion" part of the abstract, the second sentence in that paragraph reads: "Using these methods in children younger than 1 month, the majority of patients without meningitis can be differentiated from those with meningitis despite the CSF abnormalities associated with a traumatic LP." That sentence should now read: "Using these methods in children >1 month, the majority of patients without meningitis can be differentiated from those with meningitis despite the CSF abnormalities associated with a traumatic LP."
