In the Results section on page 910, the first full paragraph in column 2, lines 5–7, the authors wrote: “Rates of spina bifida decreased 21% for white infants, 13% for black infants, and 33% for Hispanic infants.” It should read: “Rates of spina bifida decreased 13% for white infants, 21% for black infants, and 33% for Hispanic infants.”

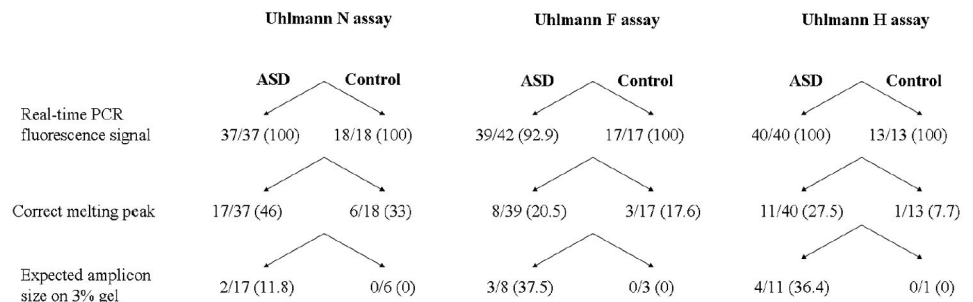
