

The following 3 errors occurred in this article by Ohlsson et al, titled “NIDCAP: A Systematic Review and Meta-analyses of Randomized Controlled Trials,” published in the March 2013 issue of *Pediatrics* (2013;131[3]:e881–e893; doi: 10.1542/2012-2121). On page e882, under the Introduction section, paragraph 1, line 6, the copy reads: “It requires trained and certified caregivers to use the Assessment of Premature Infant Behavior (APIB) tool to observe 91 neonatal behaviors every 2 minutes for 1 hour before, during, and after a caregiving intervention.” This should have read: “It requires trained and certified caregivers to use the NIDCAP assessment tool to observe 91 neonatal behaviors every 2 minutes for 1 hour before, during, and after a caregiving intervention.” On page e882, under the heading Secondary Short-Term Outcomes, paragraph 1, line 11, the copy reads: “Prechtl general movements assessments¹⁷ performed at 2 weeks CA.” This should have read: “Prechtl Neurological Examination of the Fullterm Infant¹⁷ performed at 2 weeks CA.” On page e891, under the Discussion heading, paragraph 2, line 15, the copy reads: “NIDCAP is resource-consuming, labor-intensive, and expensive both to implement and maintain, because it requires developmental specialists, regular APIB assessments, and training of nursing staff.⁴⁹” This should have read: “NIDCAP is resource-consuming, labor-intensive, and expensive both to implement and maintain, because it requires developmental specialists, regular NIDCAP assessments, and training of nursing staff.⁴⁹”
