## ERRATA

In the article "Psychoactive Medicinal and Nonmedicinal Drug Use Among High School Students" by Roush, Thompson, and Berberian (*Pediatrics* 66: 709-715, 1980) error has been noted in Table 4 (p 713). Under the heading Student Characteristics, the eighth line should read Being White.

In the letter "Linoleic Acid Supplementation" by Parsons and Pencharz (*Pediatrics* 66:812-813, 1980) an error has been noted in the 15th line of the letter (p 812, column 1). The sentence should read: Furthermore, it must be realized that the conversion of dietary fat to tissue fat is approximately 99% efficient, whereas the conversion of carbohydrate to fat (14 glucose + 12 O<sub>2</sub> → tripalmitylglycerate + 33 CO<sub>2</sub> + 21 adenosine triphosphate) results in a loss of approximately 15% of the ingested energy.<sup>3</sup>
