5-19-Year-Olds	
Score	Measure
0, 1	<p>Self-care Because of health, child needs help eating, dressing, bathing, or using the toilet.</p>
0, 1	<p>Mobility Child's health limits him or her in using public transportation or riding a bicycle; child needs help in getting around neighborhood because of health; child has to stay indoors most or all of day because of health; child is in bed or chair for most or all of day because of health.</p>
